## 100<sup>th</sup> Day of School Primary Word Problems

1. Counting and Addition - On the 100th day of school, Emma drew 25 stars, Lily drew 30 hearts, and Jackson drew circles. How many shapes did they draw in total?
2. Subtraction Story- For the 100th day project, there were 100 stickers, and Emma used 42. How many stickers are left for Lily to use?
3. Pattern Play - On the 100th day, Sarah colored every 10th square on a 10x10 grid. How many squares did she color?
4. Time Travel - During the 100th day celebration, students clapped for 100 seconds. If they started clapping at 2:30 PM, when did they finish?
5. Equal Sharing - In the 100th day candy jar, there are 100 candies. If 4 friends share them equally, how many candies does each friend get?
6. Tens and Ones - Johnny has collected 87 buttons, and Jenny has 56 buttons for the 100th day craft. How many buttons do they have altogether?
7. Shape Composition - For the 100th day art project, Emily used 45 triangle shapes, 20 circle shapes, and the rest were squares. How many square shapes did she use?
8. Word Problem Fun - During the 100th day picnic, there were 100 cookies. If 30 cookies were chocolate chip and the rest were oatmeal raisin, how many cookies were oatmeal raisin?
9. Building with Blocks - For the 100th day building challenge, Jack used 42 blocks to build a tower, and Mia used 38 blocks for her tower. How many blocks did they use in total?
10. Counting by Fives - During the 100th day parade, every 5th student carried a flag. If there were 100 students in the parade, how many students carried flags?
