100th Day of School Elementary Word Problems

1. Counting Collections - On the 100th day of school, Mrs. Johnson's class collected 100 buttons. They sorted them into 4 jars with the same number of buttons in each. How many buttons are in each jar?
2. Skip Counting Celebration - During the 100th day parade, every 5th student wore a special hat. If there were 100 students in the parade, how many students had the special hats?
3. Hundred's Hunt - For the 100th day scavenger hunt, Sarah found 32 pennies, 45 paperclips, and the rest were marbles. If she found a total of 100 items, how many marbles did she find?
4. Delicious Division - In the 100th day cake, there are 8 rows of 12 cupcakes each. How many cupcakes are there in total?
5. Time Tally - During the 100th day celebration, the teacher clapped 100 times. If each clap took 2 seconds, how many minutes did the clapping last?
6. One Hundred Patterns - Sophie arranged 100 colorful beads in a pattern. She used 3 beads for each bracelet. How many bracelets did she make, and how many beads were left?
7. Balloon Bonanza - For the 100th day balloon drop, there were 4 colors of balloons. If 25 balloons were red, 30 were blue, 20 were green, and the rest were yellow, how many yellow balloons were there?
8. Money Math on the 100th Day - In the class store for the 100th day, a toy costs 12 cents, and a sticker costs 5 cents. If Sarah had 100 cents, how many toys and stickers could she buy at most?
9. 100th Day Books - A library has 100 new books. If they want to place them equally on 5 shelves, how many books will be on each shelf?
10. 100th Day Collections - On the 100th day, each student brought 10 items for a class collection. If there are 25 students in the class, how many items do they have in total?
