



## ANSWERS

### **Prologue**

a short introductory section in a novel that sets the stage for what is to come in the story

appears only before the main body of the text

provides important background information that effects the reader's ability to fully understand the events of the story

Only fiction has a prologue

Not every novel has one

a prologue usually requires exposition later in the story

### **Both Prologue and Foreword**

both are part of a book's front matter

both are relatively short

### **Foreword**

written by someone other than the author

is not a part of the story, but a commentary on it

both fiction and nonfiction can have one
