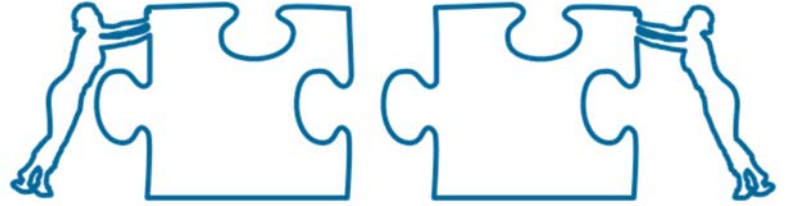


National Puzzle Day
