Several regions in the world still experience extremely low literacy rates, often **do** to a combination of complex factors. Sub-Saharan Africa, parts of South Asia, and some countries in the Middle East and North Africa have among the lowest literacy rates globally. In these areas, barriers to education include limited **accessing** to schools, particularly in remote or conflict-affected regions. Poverty plays a significant role, as families struggling to meet basic needs may prioritize labor over education for their children. **g**ender disparities in education persist in some places, with girls facing more obstacles to access and complete schooling.

Political **enstability** and armed conflicts disrupt education systems and displace populations, making it difficult for children to attend school. Cultural norms and traditions can also hinder education, as some societies may not prioritize formal **education especially** for girls. Lack of infrastructure, qualified teachers, and educational resources further exacerbate the problem. International efforts, including foreign aid and partnerships with NGOs, aim to **addresses** these challenges and improve literacy rates in these regions. Literacy programs often focus on providing access to education, especially for marginalized groups, and promoting literacy as a means of empowerment and development.
