Supreme Union general during the civil war and then later 18th President of the United States.	Ulysses S. Grant
The Confederate general in charge of the Army of Northern Virginia. At the end of the war, Supreme Commander of remaining Confederate forces,	Robert E. Lee
A Union General serving under the command of Ulysses Grant during the Civil War. Best known for his "scorched earth" policy.	William Tecumseh Sherman
A major African-American abolitionist, reformer, and writer.	Frederick Douglas
A beloved Confederate general. He was accidentally shot by Confederate forces at the Battle of Chancellorsville in an incident of friendly fire.	Stonewall Jackson
Chief general of the Union army in the beginning of the Civil war, taking over after Winfield Scott. He was criticized for being overly cautious.	George G. McClellan
