Concentration Camp	Places where people were concentrated and imprisoned. Conditions were poor, and they were often forced to do hard labor.
Extermination Camp	Extermination camps were used to kill “undesirable” people on a mass scale, usually using gas (carbon monoxide).
Transit Camp	Transit camps were used to hold prisoners for short periods of time before they were moved to other Nazi camps.
Forced Labor Camp	These camps housed eastern workers, foreign workers, and other people who were imprisoned specifically to perform hard labor to support the German war effort.
Prisoner of War Camp	Allied military officers and personnel who were captured by, or surrendered to, the Nazis were held in POW camps. This included British, American, French, Polish and Soviet military.
