Article #	What Rights Does It Give?
I	Freedom of religion, speech, press, assembly, and the right to petition the government.
II	Right to bear arms.
III	No Soldier shall, in time of peace be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner, nor in time of war, but in a manner to be prescribed by law.
IV	Rights against unreasonable search and seizure.
V	Rights in criminal cases.
VI	Right to a fair trial.
VII	Right to a trial by jury.
VIII	Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.
IX	The enumeration in the Constitution of certain rights shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.
X	The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.
