Why People Built Castles: For protection against attack. They were difficult for enemies to access and ideal places from which to defend against attacks.

Common Features of Castles: multiple buildings, a keep, a bailey, a curtain wall, arrow slits, moat, guardhouse at the entry gate

Ways to Attack Castles; Enemies used heavy-duty tools like the battering ram and the catapult. Siege: prevent anyone from entering or leaving the castle in an attempt to starve its inhabitants
