Polysyndeton

a literary device in which conjunctions are repeated in close succession

the opposite of asyndeton

Both Polysyndeton and Asyndeton

both have to do with manipulating conjunctions in a sentence

both break the usual grammatical rules

both call attention to the sentence and emphasize each of the items in a list

Asyndeton

a literary device in which conjunctions are omitted between phrases with no loss of grammatical accuracy

the opposite of polysyndeton
