Elegy

a poem that reflects upon death and upon someone who has died.

can also be a song

An elegy can be written for someone at any time.

Both Elegy and Eulogy

both praise and commemorate someone who has died

both can be spoken

if an elegy is read aloud at a funeral, it CAN be a eulogy

they are usually similar in tone

both speak of (usually personal) loss

both are for a specific individual

resonate so profoundly with an audience because the death of a loved one is a universal human experience.

Eulogy

A speech that is given only at a funeral
