### **Circumlocution**

Circumlocution can be intentional, but is usually unintentional, and simply a case of poor writing.

Uses more words than is necessary

Can be used in descriptive writing

Can be used intentionally for effect

### **Both Circumlocution and Equivocation**

both mean talking around something, not directly addressing it

### **Equivocation**

a deliberately ambiguous use of language intended to convince everyone that the speaker agrees with them

always intentional in order to avoid addressing something

Doesn't necessarily use more words, but pointedly avoids the point
