Dividing Exponents

1) Emily has $12p^4q^2$ books, and she plans to distribute them equally among $3pq$ bookshelves. Determine the number of books on each bookshelf.

2) John has $15a^3b^5$ candies and wants to divide them equally among $5ab$ kids. Find the number of candies each kid will receive.

3) A garden has $24m^5n^3$ flowers, and the gardener wants to plant them equally in $4mn$ rows. Determine the number of flowers.

4) Samantha has $10x^2y^3$ apples, and she plans to distribute them equally among $2xy$ baskets. Calculate the number of apples in each basket.

5) Liam has $16c^6d^4$ candies, and he wants to divide them equally among $4cd^2$ students. Determine the number of candies each student will receive,
