



## ANSWERS

Intertextuality refers to the fact that all texts (in the broadest sense of the word, including novels, philosophy, journalism, song lyrics, and all works of art in general) are interconnected. Every text that is created is affected by the content, reasoning, and aesthetic choices of all the texts that preceded it.

An allusion is an a reference to something. The thing being referenced can be a person, place, or thing either from real life or from a book, television, song, etc. It can also be a quality that thing represents. The thing/quality being referenced isn't mentioned directly because the writer assumes that their reader will "get" the reference.
