### **Pathetic Fallacy**

In it's strictest sense, the pathetic fallacy only applies to objects in nature

Is similar to personification only when used as a figure of speech

When used as a rhetorical device, it means appealing to emotions in an argument rather than using logic or reason.

### **Both Pathetic Fallacy and Personification**

Both describe non-human animals or objects as having human emotions

### **Personification**

Can occur with "natural" or man-made objects

Is not also a rhetorical device
