The denouement is what happens at the very end of the story. It is the final part of a story in which all the strands of the plot are drawn together and everything is explained or resolved.

The denouement follows the story's falling action, which is the part of the plot right after the climax, where the tension begins to abate and the story moves towards a resolution.

The resolution is the part of the story where a character solves a main problem, often part of the climax.
