at first glance a truism might seem profound or insightful, but it actually says nothing new or interesting.

open to interpretation

Both Truism and Tautology

neither add any new information

Tautology

the logical term for the extreme version of a truism

a statement whose predicate is contained in its subject

not open to interpretation
