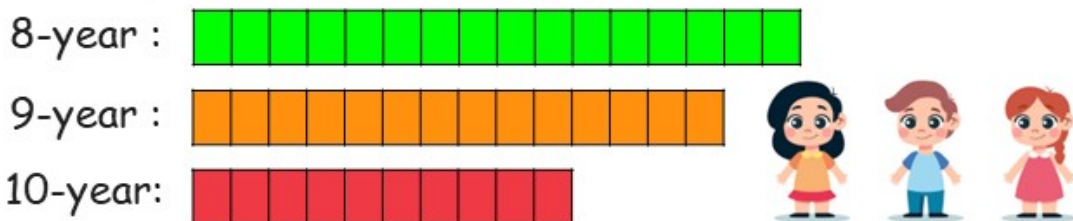

## WORKSHEET 4 - TAPE DIAGRAMS

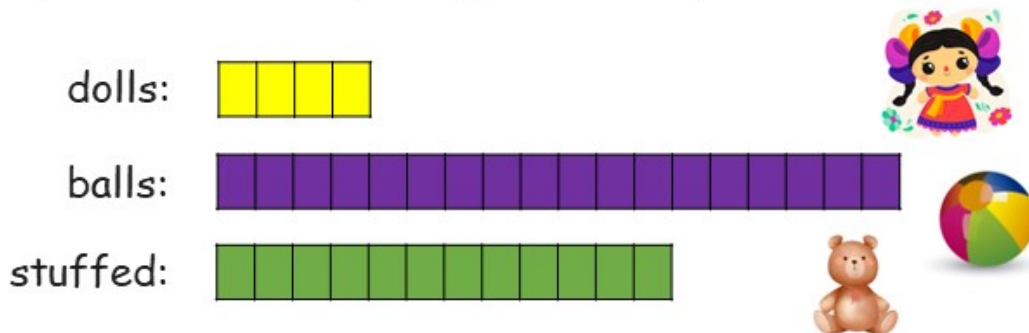
Exercises to Practice Tape Diagrams.

1. In a class there are 16 8-year-old students, 14 9-year-old students and 10 10-year-old students. What age group has the most students and how many more? Represent the quantities with a tape diagram and compare the lengths.



Answer: The 8 year old group has more students.

2. In a toy store there are 4 dolls, 18 balls and 12 stuffed animals. What type of toy is there in the smallest quantity and how many fewer are there? Represent the quantities with a tape diagram and compare the lengths.



Answer: Dolls are the type of toy that exists in the smallest quantity.
