## Converting Cups, Pints, Quarts, and Gallons.

Read the questions and compare between Cups, Pints, Quarts, and Gallons.

1) Sarah has a recipe that calls for 2 quarts of vegetable broth. How many pints is this equivalent to?  <b>Answer: 4 pints</b>	2) Jake needs to fill a container with 3 gallons of water. How many quarts of water does he need?  <b>Answer: 12 quarts</b>
3) Emily is making a punch for a party and needs 5 cups of orange juice. How many pints of orange juice does she need?  <b>Answer: 2.5 pints</b>	4) David is making pasta sauce and needs 1.5 quarts of diced tomatoes. How many cups of diced tomatoes is this equivalent to?  <b>Answer: 6 cups</b>
5) Rachel wants to make lemonade and needs 3 gallons of lemon juice. How many cups of lemon juice does she need?  <b>Answer: 48 cups</b>	6) Mia is making pancakes and needs 2.5 quarts of milk. How many cups of milk does she need?  <b>Answer: 10 cups</b>
7) Alex is filling a jug with 8 pints of water. How many gallons of water does the jug hold?  <b>Answer: 1 gallon</b>	8) Sophia is making soup and needs 3 cups of chicken broth. How many quarts of chicken broth does she need?  <b>Answer: 0.75 quarts</b>
9) Liam is making chili and needs 4 cups of kidney beans. How many quarts of kidney beans does he need?  <b>Answer: 1 quart</b>	10) Emma is filling a water pitcher with 10 cups of water. How many pints of water does the pitcher hold?  <b>Answer: 5 pints</b>
