Who has more sugar, Sarah or John?</p> <p><b>Answer: Sarah has more sugar.</b></p>             | <p>2) David has 5 tablespoons of flour, and Emily has 20 teaspoons of flour. Who has less flour, David or Emily?</p> <p><b>Answer: David has less flour.</b></p>                   |
| <p>3) Lisa has 6 tablespoons of milk, and Tom has 24 teaspoons of milk. Who has more milk, Lisa or Tom?</p> <p><b>Answer: Tom has more milk.</b></p>                       | <p>4) Alex has 8 teaspoons of oil, and Mary has 4 tablespoons of oil. Who has less oil, Alex or Mary?</p> <p><b>Answer: Alex has less oil.</b></p>                                 |
| <p>5) Rachel has 9 tablespoons of vinegar, and Peter has 30 teaspoons of vinegar. Who has more vinegar, Rachel or Peter?</p> <p><b>Answer: Peter has more vinegar.</b></p> | <p>6) Jessica has 28 teaspoons of honey, and Kevin has 8 tablespoons of honey.
