Who has more stickers, and by how many?</p> <p><i>Sara has more stickers than Sam by 24,691 stickers.</i></p>	<p>2) A farm harvested 560,000 apples and another farm harvested 480,000 apples. Which farm harvested more apples, and by how many?</p> <p><i>The first farm harvested more apples by 80,000 apples.</i></p>
<p>3) There are 540,000 residents in City A and 480,000 residents in City B. Which city has more residents, and by how many?</p> <p><i>City A has more residents than City B by 60,000 residents.</i></p>	<p>4) A school library has 380,000 books, and another library has 320,000 books. How many more books does the first library have compared to the second library?</p> <p><i>The first library has 60,000 more books than the second library.</i></p>
<p>5) A factory produced 600,000 pencils and another factory produced 520,000 pencils. Which factory produced more pencils, and by how many?</p> <p><i>The first factory produced more pencils by 80,000 pencils.</i></p>	<p>6) A bakery sold 450,000 cookies last week and 380,000 cookies this week. How many fewer cookies were sold this week compared to last week?</p> <p><i>70,000 fewer cookies were sold this week.</i></p>
<p>7) Lucas has 560,000 LEGO bricks, and Lily has 510,000 LEGO bricks. Who has more LEGO bricks, and by how many?</p> <p><i>Lucas has more LEGO bricks than Lily by 50,000 bricks.</i></p>	<p>8) A factory produced 500,000 shirts and another factory produced 420,000 shirts. Which factory produced more shirts, and by how many?</p> <p><i>The second factory produced more shirts by 80,000 shirts.</i></p>
