blindness	inability to see
Dyslexia	A learning disorder characterized by difficulty reading
deafness	inability to hear
Amputation	the removal of a limb by trauma, medical illness, or surgery
speech impairment	disorders of speech sounds, fluency, or voice that interfere with communication
mobility impairment	limitations on a person's ability to move or coordinate movement
visual impairment	any degree of vision loss, from partial to complete blindness
hearing impairment	a partial or complete loss of the ability to hear and distinguish sounds
intellectual disability	a disability that affects the acquisition of knowledge and skills
Autism Spectrum Disorder	neurological and developmental condition that affects how people interact with others,
Tourette Syndrome	a neurological disorder characterized by involuntary tics and vocalizations
Post Traumatic Stress Disorder	persistent mental and emotional stress as a result of injury or severe psychological shock
Cerebral Palsy	neurological disorders that affect muscle coordination and body movement
Down Syndrome	a congenital condition characterized by a distinctive pattern of physical characteristics
Multiple Sclerosis	a chronic neurological condition that affects the brain and spinal cord
spinal cord injury	damage to the spinal cord
