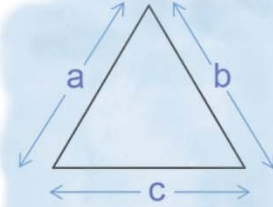

## Perimeter of Triangles

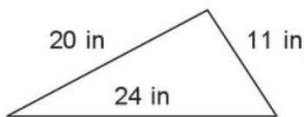
The perimeter of a triangle is the total length of the sides of a triangle. If  $a$ ,  $b$ , and  $c$  are the sides of a triangle then

$$\text{Perimeter} = a + b + c.$$



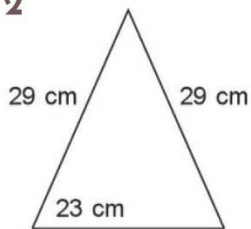

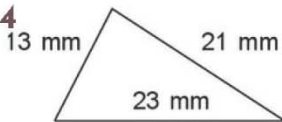
