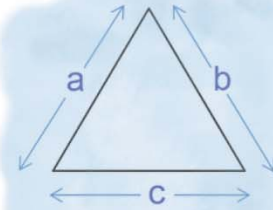


Perimeter of Triangles



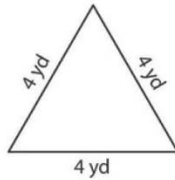
The perimeter of a triangle is the total length of the sides of a triangle. If a , b , and c are the sides of a triangle then

$$\text{Perimeter} = a + b + c.$$



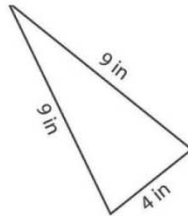
