



## ANSWERS

1. Imagery is language that creates images in the reader's mind. Imagery brings writing to life.
2. Imagery can be straightforward descriptive language, or it can be figurative or metaphorical language which puts abstract concepts in concrete terms so that they are more easily understood.
3. Haiku is a very short poem, so every word and syllable must count to create meaning. Haiku is typically rich in imagery, which evokes an experience of nature and/or emotions in the reader.
