How It Appears in The Giver

though the society may seem ideal on the surface, it is ultimately undesirable, frightening, or dehumanizing

The Community seems peaceful and structured, but they kill (release) anyone who threatens that peace and structure.

an intrinsically human value is missing

The people in The Community have no memory of human history. The Giver holds it all for them, as well as all the pain and wisdom.

the story includes the protagonist's discovery that their society is not what it seems to be

Jonas discovers that releasing the newchildren really means killing them.

the society is usually isolated or contained in some way; there is an other place where things are different

The Community is isolated from the rest of the world.
