- **Ponyboy's Eulogy/Elegy**
 - Focus on Johnny's bravery in saving the children, his innocence, and his advice to "stay gold."
 - Tone: heartfelt, emotional, poetic.
- **Dally's Eulogy/Elegy**
 - Could be angry, frustrated at the unfairness of Johnny's death.
 - Tone: tough on the surface but deeply broken inside.
- **Two-Bit's Eulogy/Elegy**
 - Might mix humor and sadness, remembering Johnny as "our quiet kid with the biggest heart."
 - Tone: bittersweet.
- **Sodapop's Eulogy/Elegy**
 - Gentle, compassionate, focusing on Johnny's kindness and brotherhood.
 - Tone: tender and comforting.
- **Themes to Include:**
 - **Loss & innocence** → Johnny as a symbol of fragile goodness.
 - **Brotherhood & loyalty** → The gang as his family.
 - **"Stay gold"** → Holding onto beauty and hope despite hardship.
