1. Jim Crow laws were state and local laws that enforced racial segregation; they affected schools, transportation, restaurants, theaters, public facilities, and more.
2. "Separate but equal" claimed both races had access to the same services, but in reality, Black facilities were underfunded, unequal, and inferior.
3. Black citizens were often excluded from juries; trials were decided by white juries biased against Black defendants.
