



## Word Building with Affixes

### Directions:

1. Look at the prefixes and suffixes in the chart.
2. Combine them with the base words to create **new words**.
3. Each base word can be changed more than once by using different affixes.
4. Write the new words in the chart.
5. If you get stuck, try to say the word out loud to check if it sounds real.

**Example:** Base Word = *play*    Prefix: *re-* → **replay**    Suffix: *-ful* → **playful**

**Prefixes:** *re-*, *un-*, *dis-*, *pre-*, *mis-*      **Suffixes:** *-ful*, *-ness*, *-able*, *-ly*, *-er*

**Base Words:** *help*, *kind*, *use*, *teach*, *agree*, *care*, *read*, *happy*
