Emotion Intensity Tracker Sample Answer Key

Note: There is **not always one correct answer** for emotions. These are **reasonable interpretations** based on the facial expressions. Students may choose slightly different emotion words or intensity levels if they can explain their reasoning.

#	Possible Emotion	Suggested Intensity (1-10)	Reasoning
1	Happy	6	Big smile and relaxed eyes show positive emotion but not extreme excitement.
2	Worried / Concerned	7	Raised eyebrows and frowning mouth suggest worry or concern.
3	Confused / Uncertain	5	Slight frown and neutral posture suggest mild confusion.
4	Sad / Crying	8	Tear and deep frown indicate strong sadness.
5	Tired / Bored	4	Droopy eyes suggest low energy or mild boredom.
6	Silly / Playful	6	Tongue out and squinted eyes show playful or goofy energy.
7	Very Happy / Excited	8	Big open smile suggests strong happiness.
8	Cool / Confident	5	Relaxed smile and sunglasses show calm confidence.
9	Laughing Hard	9	Closed eyes and wide mouth suggest very strong laughter or joy.
10	Nervous / Worried	7	Uneven mouth and raised eyebrows suggest anxious or worried feelings.
