



Word Relationships

Type	Definition	My Example
synonyms	Words that have the same or similar meaning	
antonyms	Words that have the opposite meaning	
homonym	each of two or more words having the same spelling or pronunciation but different meanings and origins	
homophone	each of two or more words having the same pronunciation but different meanings, origins, or spelling	
hyponym	a word whose meaning is included in the meaning of another word is a hyponym	
hypernym	a word with a broad meaning (category) that more specific words fall under is the hypernym	
part to whole	the first word specifies a part to which the second word specifies the whole	
whole to part	the first word specifies the whole to which the second word specifies a part	
age to size	the first word specifies an age which corresponds to the size specified by the second word	
person to location	the first word specifies a person and the second word specifies the location with which it is associated	
object to use	the first word specifies an object and the second word specifies its use	
connotation	Words have similar meanings but different tones, nuances, or suggestions	
rhyme	correspondence of sound between words or the endings of words
