

## Context Clue Challenge Answer Key

1. She felt **joyful**, almost **happy**, all day.

**Relationship:** Synonym

**How do you know?** The sentence says “almost,” showing the words have very similar meanings. Both describe the same feeling.

2. The soup was **hot**, not **cold**, after sitting on the stove.

**Relationship:** Antonym

**How do you know?** The phrase “not cold” shows the words are opposites. Hot and cold have opposite meanings.

3. He used a **knife** to **cut** the bread.

**Relationship:** Object to Use

**How do you know?** The sentence shows what the knife is used for. A knife is an object, and cutting is its purpose.

4. The **teacher** walked into the **school** early in the morning.

**Relationship:** Person to Location

**How do you know?** The sentence shows where the teacher works or goes. A teacher is a person, and a school is the place connected to that job.

5. A **wheel** is an important part of a **car**.

**Relationship:** Part to Whole

**How do you know?** The sentence directly says the wheel is a part of the car. The car is the whole, and the wheel is one piece of it.

6. The **cat** is a type of **animal** that people often keep as a pet.

**Relationship:** Hyponym

**How do you know?** The sentence says “a type of,” which shows that a cat belongs to a larger group. Animal is the category, and cat is one example of it.
